

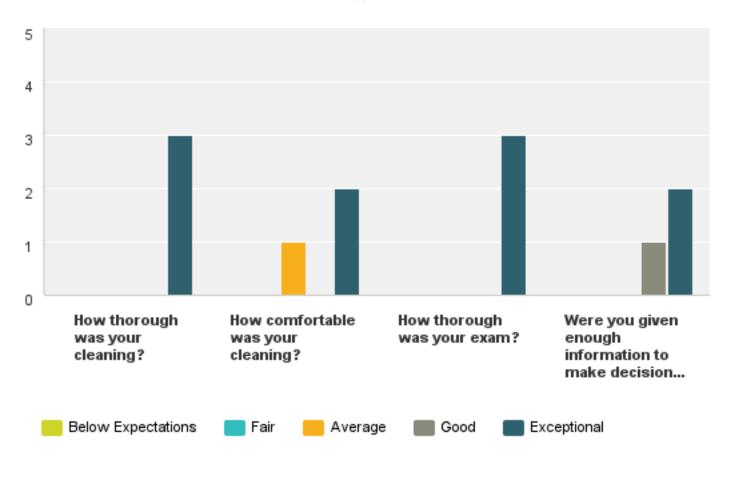

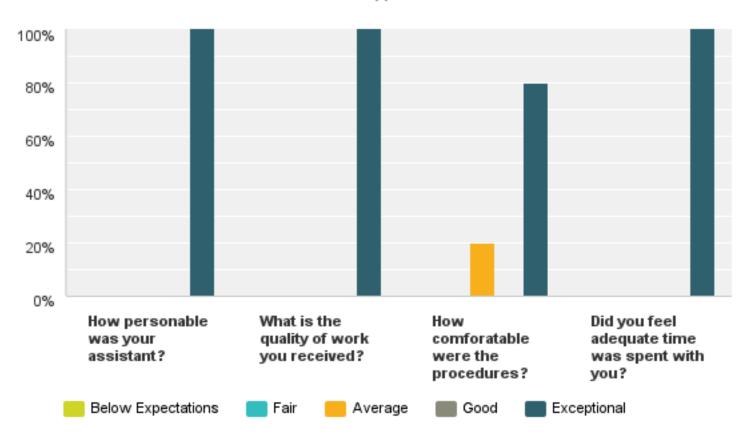


Comments on Cleaning Visits:

Q4 Dentist Visits





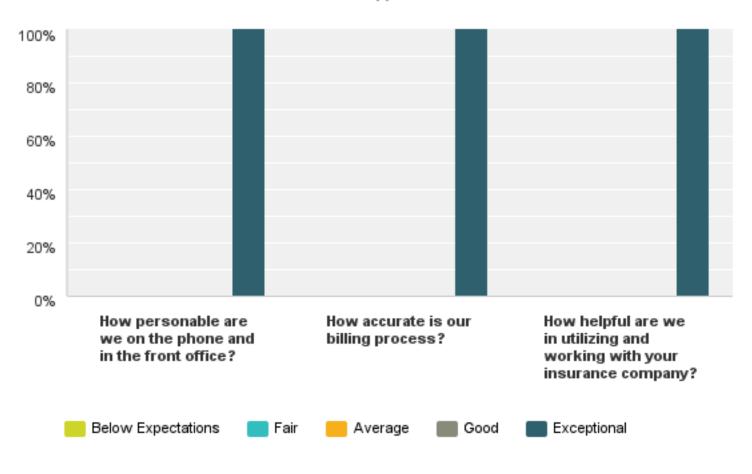
Comments on Dental Visits:

Q6 Billing & Front Office



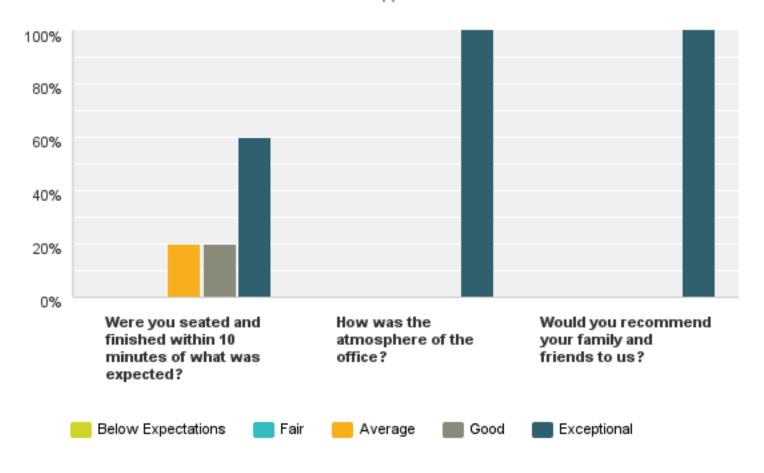


Billing & Front Desk Comments:
